State Representative Brad Pollitt Named Committee Chairman for 103rd General Assembly

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo. – State Representative Brad Pollitt is proud to announce her newly appointed House committee assignment this legislative session, as designated by House Speaker Jonathan Patterson. Rep. Pollitt will serve as Chairman of a key committee, Legislative Review, for the Missouri House of Representatives' 103rd General Assembly.
