## State Representative Marty Joe Murray Endorses Community Food Share During SNAP Suspension

**JEFFERSON CITY, Mo.** — In response to the federal suspension of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, State Representative Marty Joe Murray, along with community leaders, is hosting a Community Food Share event to assist families in need during the holiday.

The food share will be free and open to the public, with volunteers handing out pantry staples, fresh produce, and prepared meals. The event is designed to stand in solidarity with families who are unfairly caught in the middle of federal dysfunction and will take place on Saturday, November 15, from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM at the Centenary Church on Olive Street in St. Louis.

"The irony of families losing access to food support during the month of Thanksgiving cannot be ignored," said Murray, D-St. Louis. "At a time when we're supposed to gather in gratitude and abundance, tens of thousands of Missouri families are instead facing empty tables because of political gridlock."

In response to the Governor's call for the immediate spending of \$15 million through the Missouri Area Agency on Aging and TANF funds to support Missouri food banks, Representative Murray emphasized that those funds were appropriated under the assumption there would be no delay in federal SNAP assistance. "While I appreciate the Governor's action, we must recognize this is only a stopgap," Murray said. "I urge my colleagues to do more in the spring, during review of the supplemental budget, to find a way to bridge the gap fully. The federal government has made it clear that it is the state's responsibility to ensure the social programs Missourians depend on remain funded and stable."
