Missouri Future Caucus Examines AI's Impact on Missouri's Economy and Security in Second Public Meeting

St. Charles, Mo. – The Missouri Future Caucus held its second meeting on November 19 at Lindenwood University in St. Charles, focusing on the future of artificial intelligence (AI) policy in Missouri. The session brought together experts from across the public and private sectors to discuss both the opportunities and challenges of AI deployment in the state.

The meeting explored ways Missouri can capture the benefits of AI while protecting public interests. Attendees discussed the risks associated with AI use, public awareness, and the resources the state may need to remain competitive in the AI space. The Future Caucus aimed to provide House standing committees with detailed information and recommendations on legislation and budget considerations to create a better AI-equipped Missouri.
