### AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund license plate.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 301.3082, to read as follows:

**301.3082. 1. Any person may receive special license plates as prescribed by this  
2 section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an  
3 apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen  
4 thousand pounds gross weight, after an annual payment of an emblem-use authorization  
5 fee to the Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc. The Hearing Impaired Kids  
6 Endowment Fund, Inc., hereby authorizes the use of its official emblem to be affixed on  
7 multiyear personalized license plates as provided in this section. Any contribution to the  
8 Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc., derived from this section, except  
9 reasonable administrative costs, shall be used solely for the purposes of the Hearing  
10 Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc.**

**11 2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use  
12 authorization fee to the Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc., that organization  
13 shall issue to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use authorization  
14 statement, which shall be presented by the owner to the department of revenue at the time  
15 of registration of a motor vehicle. Upon presentation of the annual statement, payment of  
16 a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee and documents which may be required  
17 by law, the department of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a personalized license  
18 plate which shall bear the emblem of the Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc.**

19 **Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme**  
20 **and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as**  
21 **prescribed by section 301.130.**

22 **3. A vehicle owner, who was previously issued a plate with the Hearing Impaired**  
23 **Kids Endowment Fund, Inc., emblem authorized by this section but who does not provide**  
24 **an emblem use authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued**  
25 **a new plate which does not bear the Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund, Inc.,**  
26 **emblem, as otherwise provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules**  
27 **and regulations for the administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms**  
28 **required by this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the**  
29 **authority of this section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to**  
30 **the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.**
