	Whereas, the Railroad Retirement and Survivors Improvement Act of 2000 was approved
2 3 4	in a bipartisan effort by 391 members of the United States House of Representatives of the 106th Congress, including the entire Missouri delegation to the United States House of Representatives; and
5	Whereas, more than 83 United States Senators, including both Missouri Senator Kit Bond
6 7	and then Missouri Senator John Ashcroft, signed letters of support for this legislation in 2000; and
8	Whereas, the bill now before the 107th Congress modernizes the Railroad Retiremen
9 10	System for its 690,000 beneficiaries nationwide, including over 23,100 in Missouri; and
11	Whereas, railroad management, labor and retiree organizations have agreed to support this
12 13	legislation; and
14	Whereas, this legislation provides tax relief to freight railroads, Amtrak and commuter
15 16	lines; and
17	Whereas, this legislation provides benefit improvements for surviving spouses of rai
18 19	workers, who currently suffer deep cuts in income when the rail retiree dies; and
20	Whereas, no outside contributions from taxpayers are needed to implement the change
21 22	called for in this legislation; and
23	Whereas, all changes will be paid for from within the railroad industry, including a ful
24 25	share of active employees:
