	Whereas, the budget of the Missouri Department of Social Services has reached

14	Whereas, at a minimum seventy-six legislative districts will be represented by new
15 16 17	legislators in 2003, greatly affecting the number of legislators with a working knowledge of the budget; and
18	Whereas, a detailed summary and analysis of the core of the budget of the
19 20 21 22 23	Department of Social Services and a thorough evaluation of the effectiveness of the Department's programs in serving our young, disabled and elderly citizens and an appraisal of whether the Department uses the funds in a fiscally responsible manner would be a valuable guide to future legislators evaluating the budget for the Department of Social Services:

of Representatives of the Ninety-first General Assembly, First Regular Session, that a House 26 Interim Committee of the General Assembly be created, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives by June 1, 2001, and that said committee be authorized to function 27 during the interim between the First Regular Session and the Second Regular Session of the 28 Ninety-first General Assembly; and 29 30 Be it further resolved that said committee make an in-depth analysis of the 31 32 budget of the Department of Social Services and evaluate the effectiveness of the Department's 33 programs and appraise the Department's spending practices including the solicitation of information from appropriate state agencies and the public; and 34 35 Be it further resolved that the committee be authorized to hold hearings 36 37 as it deems advisable, and that the staff of House Research provide such legal, research, clerical, technical services and staff of the Committee on Legislative Research provide such drafting 38 39 services as requested by the committee; and 40 Be it further resolved that the committee, its members, and any staff 41 42 personnel assigned to the committee shall receive reimbursement for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings of the committee or any subcommittee thereof; and 43 44 Be it further resolved that the committee report its findings to the Missouri 45

General Assembly by December 1, 2001, and the authority of such committee shall terminate
