AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section, relating to certain public school records.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 160,067, to read as follows:

- known as section 160.067, to read as follows:

 160.067. 1. All personally identifiable student records maintained by a public
- 2 elementary or secondary school shall be kept in such a manner that such records shall not
- 3 be open for inspection to persons not employed by the school district, except as otherwise
- 4 provided by law or as otherwise provided pursuant to 34 CFR Part 99. Any personally
- 5 identifiable student records maintained on electronic media shall be maintained in such a
- 6 manner as to assure that there is no access to such records by any unauthorized person.
- 7 Except as otherwise provided by federal law, no personally identifiable student records,
- 8 however maintained, shall be made available to any person who is not employed by the
- 9 school district, except:

- 10 (1) With the prior written permission of the parent, guardian or other custodian 11 of a student under the age of eighteen years; or
- 12 (2) With the prior written permission of the parent, guardian or other custodian 13 of the student or the student, if the student is eighteen years of age or older; or
 - (3) In response to a subpoena in a pending civil or criminal action.
- 2. The provisions of this section shall not apply to section 160.261, 167.115, RSMo, or 167.117, RSMo.
