AN ACT

To repeal section 333.101, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the inspections of funeral establishments.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 333.101, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 333.101, to read as follows:

333.101. The board or any member thereof or any agent duly [authorized] **licensed** by it may enter the office, premises, establishment or place of business of any funeral service licensee in this state or any office, premises, establishment or place where the practice of funeral directing or embalming is carried on, or where such practice is advertised as being carried on for the purpose of inspecting [said] **the** office, premises or establishment and for the purpose of inspecting the license and registration of any licensee and the manner and scope of training given by the licensee to the intern operating therein.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
