## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to paraprofessional teacher assistants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 168.740, to read as follows:

168.740. 1. There is hereby established the "Missouri Paraprofessional-to-Teacher

- 2 Assistance Program" within the department of elementary and secondary education.
- 3 Subject to appropriation, this program shall provide grants to assist paraprofessional
- 4 teaching assistants in completing the college courses necessary to achieve teacher
- 5 certification, so long as the courses are taken at public institutions of higher education.
- 6 The department shall determine the appropriate qualifications of candidates for the grants,
- and shall select the recipients of the grants based upon the fulfillment of those
- 8 qualifications and need for assistance. Beginning in the 2003-2004 school year, one
- 9 hundred qualified candidates shall receive a grant pursuant to this section.
- 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall adopt any rules
- 11 necessary to implement the provisions of this section. No rule or portion of a rule
- 12 promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section shall become effective unless it has
- 13 been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.
