AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 227.319, to read as follows:

**227.319. The portion of interstate highway 55, from mile marker 129 to mile
2 marker 135, contained within a county of the third classification without a township form
3 of government and with more than eighteen thousand one hundred but less than eighteen
4 thousand two hundred inhabitants shall be designated the "Trooper James Froemsdorf
5 Memorial Highway".**
