### AN ACT

To repeal section 60.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to county surveyor residency requirements.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 60.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 60.010, to read as follows:

60.010. At the regular general election in the year 1948, and every four years thereafter, the voters of each county of this state in classes two, three and four shall elect a registered land surveyor as county surveyor, who shall hold his office for four years and until [his] a successor is duly elected, commissioned and qualified. **The surveyor may be a resident of the county in which the person is elected if required by the governing authority of the county.** The person elected shall be commissioned by the governor.
