AN ACT

To repeal section 304.570, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to failure to stop for a school bus.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 304.570, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 304.570, to read as follows:

304.570. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter or of sections
2 307.020 to 307.295, RSMo, for which no specific punishment is provided, upon conviction
3 thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than five hundred
4 dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding one year, or by both such
5 fine and imprisonment. **In addition, the court may suspend the driver's license of any**
6 **person who violates the provisions of section 304.050 for up to one hundred twenty days.**
