JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to the Constitution of Missouri relating to the prohibition of same-sex marriage.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next
2 following the first Monday in November, 2004, or at a special election to be called by the
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. The Constitution of Missouri is amended by adding thereto one new article,
2 to be known as article XIV, to read as follows:

3 **Article XIV**

4 **Marriage**

5 **Section 1. Marriage in this state shall consist only of the union of a man and a**
6 **woman, and no license to marry shall be issued except to a man and a woman. Marriage**
7 **between persons of the same sex, and full faith and credit of such marital status entered**
8 **into in another state, shall not be recognized as marriage.**
