Officials of the **City of Arnold** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **City of Boonville** assume this proposal would have no effect on their City.

Oversight assumes no state fiscal impact. Oversight assumes certain cities would have no fiscal impact unless their Council would vote a salary for Council members that would be greater than the salary set by current law. Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive and would have no local fiscal impact.

This bill allows the city council in certain third class cities to set their salaries by ordinance. Currently, council members receive \$100 per year.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
