FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would require the state and its political subdivisions to encourage the distribution of plans and specifications for the construction, remodel, or repair of facilities to all available plan rooms and electronic plan rooms in order to encourage meaningful competition, diversity, and the lowest responsible bids for such projects.

The proposal would prohibit any agreement by a public body or any body supported by tax dollars that would restrict the sources or availability of plans and specifications, or limit the distribution of plans and specifications to contractors, subcontractors and suppliers, to a single or limited number of reprographic firms, plan rooms, or electronic plan rooms, unless otherwise required by law. A single or limited number of firms or plan rooms may be used so long as that firm or plan room makes the information available to other firms and plan rooms without cost or delay.

Any existing contract which would be in violation of this act upon its enactment could not be renewed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
