This proposal repeals the provision of the law which requires county superintendents of public welfare in third and fourth classification counties to provide supervision for persons who are on parole from the state penitentiary, the Missouri Reformatory, and certain training schools.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
