AN ACT

To authorize the conveyance of property owned by the state in Cole County to the Regional West Fire District, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, transfer, grant, and convey all interest in fee simple absolute in property owned by the state in Cole County to the Regional West Fire District. The property to be conveyed is more particularly described as follows:
- 5 Part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 45 North, Range 13
- West, Cole County, Missouri, more particularly described as follows:
- 7 From the southeast corner of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of said
- 8 Section 13; thence N1°10'35"E, along the Quarter Quarter Section line,
- 9 1071.37 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING for this description; thence
- 10 S38°35'30"W, 113.29 feet; thence N51°24'30"W, 348.48 feet; thence
- 11 N38°35'30"E, 250.00 feet to a point on the southerly right-of-way line of

- 2. The commissioner of administration shall set the terms and conditions for the sale as the commissioner deems reasonable. Such terms and conditions may include, but are not limited to, the number of appraisals required, the time, place, and terms of the sale.

 3. The attorney general shall approve the form of the instrument of conveyance.
 Section B. Because of the urgent need to provide adequate fire protection for certain
 citizens in the state of Missouri, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an
 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full
 force and effect upon its passage and approval.
