Reported from the Committee on Rules March 17, 2005 with recommendation that the bill Do Pass with no time limit for debate.

AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of a highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 227.363, to read as follows:

**227.363. The portion of state route H in Clay County from the intersection of state
2 route H and Richfield Road north to the intersection of state route H and state route B
3 shall be designated the "Richard L. Harriman Highway". Costs for such designation shall
4 be paid by private donations.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
