DESCRIPTION


Any person that is not a licensed physician who performs or induces an abortion is guilty of a class A misdemeanor. The proposal specifies that a physician who performs an abortion and does not have clinical privileges at a hospital which offers obstetrical or gynecological care within 30 miles of the location where the abortion is performed is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

This proposal defines an establishment operated for the purpose of performing or inducing any second or third-trimester abortions or five or more first-trimester abortions per month as an ambulatory surgical center.
