FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of **Jefferson County** assume no fiscal impact.

In response to similar legislation (HB 177), the following statements were issued.

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** state their department presently has its sex offender registry online. Therefore, the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Oversight assumes the proposal is permissive and would have no fiscal impact. However, if the chief law enforcement officer of the county elects to establish a searchable registered sexual offender web page on the Internet, the county may experience a fiscal impact. Since the language is permissive, Oversight assumes no impact.

Officials from the **Greene, Clark, Andrew, Butler, Marion, Franklin and Callaway County Sheriff's Office, Jackson County Sheriff's Office, and St. Louis County Police Department** did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


