FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** stated there would be no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Saint Louis County Board of Elections** stated there would be no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Platte County Board of Elections** stated that school districts and not the election board itself, will incur expenses related to the conduct of the election.

Officials from the **Kansas City Election Board** stated that if the school district annexation election were to be administered by the Kansas City Election Board, the costs could reflect current levels of expenditure at approximately \$1,200 per poll.

Oversight assumes an annexation election would be held during a regularly scheduled election and related costs would be minimal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

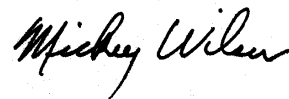
DESCRIPTION

Currently, a school district can petition to be attached to an adjacent district upon petition of at least 10% of the district voters voting in the last school board election or by a majority of district voters, whichever is less. This proposal adds a minimum of 50 voters for either alternative.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
