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### AN ACT

To amend chapter 338, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to dispensing of drugs.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 338, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 338.400, to read as follows:

338.400. 1. As used in this section the term "veterinary legend drug" means a drug  
2 that is restricted to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian under any law or  
3 regulation of the federal government.

4 2. No corporation, limited liability company, partnership, or other business entity  
5 shall be required to obtain a license to engage in the practice of pharmacy under this  
6 chapter in order to dispense any veterinary legend drug to a consumer possessing a  
7 prescription for such drug that has been written by a veterinarian licensed under chapter  
8 340, RSMo.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
