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### AN ACT

To repeal section 191.332, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to newborn screening.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 191.332, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 191.332, to read as follows:

- 191.332. 1. By January 1, 2002, the department of health and senior services shall, subject to appropriations, expand the newborn screening requirements in section 191.331 to include potentially treatable or manageable disorders, including **but not limited to** cystic fibrosis, galactosemia, biotinidase deficiency, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, maple syrup urine disease (MSUD) and other amino acid disorders, glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase deficiency (G-6-PD), MCAD and other fatty acid oxidation disorders, methylmalonic acidemia, propionic acidemia, isovaleric acidemia [and] **or** glutaric acidemia Type I.
2. The department of health and senior services may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
