AN ACT

To amend chapter 321, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the board of directors of a fire protection district.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 321, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 321.165, to read as follows:

3 **321.165. Within six months of election to the board, the members of the board shall**
4 **attend and complete an educational seminar or conference, or other suitable training on**
5 **the role and duties of a board member of a fire protection district. The board of directors**
6 **shall determine the educational seminars or conferences, or other suitable training that will**
7 **meet the requirements of this section; provided that such approved seminars, conferences,**
8 **or training at a minimum provide information on all relevant state statutes and rules,**
including the state sunshine laws, and the financial responsibilities and ethical
considerations associated with membership on the board of directors.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
