

HB 423 -- MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Kuessner

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass by consent" by the Committee on Transportation by a vote of 16 to 0.

This bill designates a portion of State Highway M, within the city limits of Irondale, in Washington County as the "Highway Patrolman Robert Kolilis Memorial Highway."

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2006, FY 2007, and FY 2008.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill will be a fitting tribute to a person who gave his life trying to protect us.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Kuessner; and Missouri State Troopers Association.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
