### AN ACT

To amend chapter 414, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to ethanol blend fuel.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 414, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 414.250, to read as follows:

**414.250. 1. On or before January 1, 2007, all motor fuel sold or offered for sale in  
2 Missouri for use in vehicles equipped to operate on gasoline shall be a fuel ethanol blend,  
3 unless the United States Environmental Protection Agency or the governor by executive  
4 order promulgates rules which prohibit, limit, or otherwise regulate the use of  
5 ethanol-blended fuels in ozone nonattainment areas, as defined by Section 107 of the  
6 federal Clean Air Act, as amended, or in an area designated as a maintenance area for  
7 ozone under Section 175A of the federal Clean Air Act, as amended.**

**8 2. For purposes of this section, "fuel ethanol blend" means a mixture of ninety  
9 percent gasoline and ten percent fuel ethanol in which the gasoline portion of the blend or  
10 the finished blend meets the American Society for Testing and Materials - specification  
11 number D-439.**
