### AN ACT

To amend chapter 307, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to failure to lower tinted windows, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 307, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 307.174, to read as follows:

307.174. 1. A person commits the crime of failure to lower tinted windows if such  
2 person is an occupant of a motor vehicle and fails to fully lower any tinted windows, over  
3 which such person has automated or manual control, upon the approach of a law  
4 enforcement officer who has stopped the vehicle to investigate a traffic violation or other  
5 criminal offense.

6 2. Failure to lower tinted windows is a class C misdemeanor.

7 3. The provisions of this section shall not prevent a municipality from enacting a  
8 local ordinance which creates the ordinance violation of failure to lower tinted windows.
