### AN ACT

To repeal section 167.029, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to school uniforms.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 167.029, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 167.029, to read as follows:

167.029. [A] **Each** public school district [in any city not within a county shall] **may** determine whether a dress code policy requiring pupils to wear a school uniform is appropriate at any school or schools within such district, and if it is so determined, [shall] **may** adopt such a policy. The school district may determine the style and color of the school uniform.
