6	farms, hay, cotton, and corn production, and cattle, hog, and turkey production, and more; and

9	important to our communities, to our state, and to our nation; and

11	$\mathbf{W}\mathbf{hereas}$, with the introduction of the Missouri Animal Identification Program, a
12	coordinated effort between the Missouri Department of Agriculture and the United States
13	Department of Agriculture, the issues of food security and personal freedom became a reality for
14	Missouri agriculture producers; and

16	Whereas, the United States Department of Agriculture National Identification
17	System (NAIS) is currently, should remain, a voluntary program with regard to animal
18	identification programs and marketing practices:
