FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill allows rather than mandates that an election authority provide each polling place in its jurisdiction with 55 ballots for every 50 registered voters.

The bill contains an emergency clause.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
