AN ACT

To amend chapter 388, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to railroads.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 388, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 388.461, to read as follows:

**388.461. Every railroad corporation owning or operating a railroad that traverses
2 through any city of the fourth classification with more than five thousand four hundred
3 but less than five thousand five hundred inhabitants and located in more than one county
4 shall establish a suitable stopping place, depot, or union station within such city to
5 accommodate the boarding and unboarding of passengers.**
