AN ACT

To amend chapter 163, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school funding.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 163, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 163.095, to read as follows:

3 **163.095. For any district in the county with a charter form of government and with**
4 **more than one million inhabitants that in calendar year 2005 (school year 2005-2006)**
5 **erroneously set a levy in the capital projects fund rather than the incidental fund and**
6 **reported the capital projects amount to the county for which the county issued tax notices**
7 **and the district received taxes for calendar year 2005, the department of elementary and**
8 **secondary education shall calculate the amount the district would have received in state**
9 **school aid for fiscal year 2006 had the district placed the levy in the incidental fund rather**
10 **than the capital projects fund and use this revised 2005-2006 calculated funding amount**
in the distribution of state school aid for fiscal year 2007 and subsequent years. The
calculation shall not change the actual funding due the district for the 2005-2006 year.
