Whereas, his Springfield-style "cashew chicken" made up of chunks of fried chicken covered with a thick oyster sauce and topped with green onions and cashews soon became a gustatory hit in the area; and

Whereas, now eighty-eight years of age, David Leong is retired from the restaurant business, but his recipe for cashew chicken is still served throughout Springfield and its environs at more than one hundred locations; and

Whereas, David Leong is justifiably proud also to be known as the beloved husband of the late Wong Shau Ngor and the loving father of seven children:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the well-deserved selection of David Leong for a 2008 Pinnacle Award from the Springfield Convention and Visitors Bureau, to commend his entrepreneurial actions that led to the invention of the "cashew chicken" delicacy, and to convey this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued success in life for many more years to come; and
