Whereas, Blake DeWitt demonstrated his significant potential as a Major League player during the National League Divisional Series and Championship Series when he batted .167 and drove in 6 runs in 8 games for the Dodgers; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse daily activities in order to acknowledge milestone events in the lives of such outstanding Missouri citizens as Blake DeWitt:
