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**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 392, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to caller location information.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 392, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 392.415, to read as follows:

392.415. 1. Upon request, a telecommunications carrier shall provide call location  
2 information concerning the user of a telecommunications service, including a wireless  
3 telecommunications service, in an emergency situation to a law enforcement official or  
4 agency in order to respond to a call for emergency service by a subscriber, customer, or  
5 user of such service, or to provide caller location information (or do a ping locate) in an  
6 emergency situation that involves danger of death or serious physical injury to any person  
7 where disclosure of communications relating to the emergency is required without delay.  
8 2. No cause of action shall lie in any court of law against any telecommunications  
9 carrier or telecommunications service, or its officers, employees, agents, or other specified  
10 persons, for providing any information, facilities, or assistance to a law enforcement  
11 official or agency in accordance with the terms of this section.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
