AN ACT

To amend chapter 115, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to voter registration for hunting and fishing permit applicants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 115, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 115.164, to read as follows:

115.164. 1. The secretary of state's office shall provide voter registration application forms to the department of conservation for distribution to local offices and permit vendors.

2. All department of conservation offices and local permit vendors authorized by the department to issue resident hunting and fishing permits shall make voter registration application forms available to all applicants who apply for resident hunting and fishing permits at the department office or local permit vendor. Such applicants may mail the completed voter registration application to the appropriate election authority.

3. All department of conservation offices and local permit vendors authorized by the department to issue resident hunting and fishing permits may inform any applicant for a resident hunting or fishing permit who applies by telephone that the applicant may request that a voter registration application be mailed to the applicant. Such applicants may mail the completed voter registration application to the appropriate election authority.
