AN ACT

To repeal section 227.303, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the designation of a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 227.303, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 227.303, to read as follows:

227.303. The portion of interstate highway 70 within a city not within a county to the border with the state of Illinois [shall be] **formerly** designated as the "Mark McGwire Highway" **shall be renamed the "John F. Bass Memorial Highway". All signage shall be paid for through private sources and shall meet appropriate specifications set forth by the department of transportation.**

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
