	Whereas, the Tenth Amendment of the Constitution of the United States reads as

5	Whereas, the Tenth Amendment defines the total scope of federal power as being
6 7	that specifically granted by the Constitution of the United States and no more; and
8	Whereas, the founders of this nation rejected the principles of socialism,
9 10 11 12	communism and other forms of tyrannical governments that allow for redistribution of the wealth, preferring instead to set up a constitutional republic form of government, based upon Judeo-Christian beliefs, that encourages personal responsibility; and
13	Whereas, the Declaration of Independence was written for the purpose of freeing
14 15 16 17 18 19	these United States from the tyranny of a government that would not listen to its citizens, as set forth in the following language: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of HappinessThat to secure these Rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just Powers from the Consent of the Governed"; and
