FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on the Courts.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Office of the Director** and **Missouri State Highway Patrol** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** state they would need to develop new notices, update the driver guide and the GDL information, and update the website. This could be done with existing resources.

The **Office of Administration Information Technology (ITSD DOR)** estimates that this legislation could be implemented utilizing 1 existing CIT III for 3 months at a rate of \$4,441/mo for a total cost of \$13,323. ITSD DOR estimates the IT portion of this request can be accomplished within existing resources; however; if priorities shift, additional FTE/overtime would be needed to implement.
