FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 210.135:

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, **Office of the Attorney General**, **University of Missouri** and the **Department of Corrections** each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services** assume there is no fiscal impact to the Department. Currently, many school facilities and medical institutions have protocols in place which direct individuals to notify designated staff responsible for calling the child abuse and neglect hotline of suspected abuse or neglect. This legislation supports those protocols.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety** have not responded to Oversight's request for fiscal information.
