### FISCAL ANALYSIS

## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions**, and **Professional Registration**, **Department of Revenue**, **Department of Social Services**, **Department of Conservation**, and the **Office of Prosecution Services** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** assume costs will be realized due to an increase in jail commitments for those found in contempt. It costs approximately \$62.50 per day to house a person in the Boone County Jail. Officials cannot project the increase in the number of persons that will be committed to jail based on this legislation.

**Oversight** assumes county sheriff's departments could experience increased jail costs due to the provisions in the proposal. Oversight assumes the statewide fiscal impact to be unknown, as the number of commitments can not be projected.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Greene County Sheriff's Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, and the Platte County Sheriff's Department did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

## FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation allows the recipient of child support or the Family Support Division within the Department of Social Services to commence a civil contempt proceeding in the circuit court of the county in which the child support order was filed or registered against a person who has been ordered to pay child support and fails or refuses to do so if an order of income withholding is inapplicable or unsuccessful. If the person ordered to pay fails to appear in response to the contempt proceeding, the court must find the person in contempt for failure to appear and issue a warrant or find the person in contempt for the reasons in the original motion. If a warrant is issued, the person will be subject to arrest and if apprehended or detained, will be held until the hearing unless a cash performance bond is deposited.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
