FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Alcohol and Tobacco Control** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission** anticipate that this bill will not significantly alter its caseload. However, if other similar bills also pass, there will be fiscal impact. If there are more cases, or more complex cases, there could be a fiscal impact.

In response to a similar proposal from this year (SB 346), officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assumed that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed within existing resources.
