## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials from the **City of Monett** state since they will not conduct another municipal election until 2012, the savings for the three fiscal years in the note will be zero. However, in 2012, the savings will be approximately \$10,841 assuming the number of candidates equal the number of open positions.

Officials from the **City of West Plains** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes the proposal will not have a fiscal impact to the two cities since it is permissive in nature.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
