FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator (CTS)** assume, for each circuit judge, the cost is as follows:

Circuit Court Judge: \$120,484 per year, plus fringe benefits Court Reporter: \$55,012 per year, plus fringe benefits

CTS assumes the total cost for this legislation would be approximately \$150,000 in FY 2010 (six months) and approximately \$310,000 in subsequent years.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **38**th **Circuit Court – Christian and Taney Counties** assume they would incur office expenses in the amount of \$2,000 in FY 2010 and \$4,000 in subsequent years.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Beginning January 1, 2010, the proposed legislation authorizes, one additional circuit judge position in the 38th Judicial Circuit. The judge who sits on December 31, 2009, will be the circuit judge in Christian County in division one beginning January 1, 2010, until his or her term ends or a successor is elected and qualified. The circuit judge in Taney County in division two will be elected in 2010.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
