#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety** – **Missouri State Highway Patrol** and the **Office of the State Public Defender** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Department of Corrections (DOC)** state their files do not include information as to specific firearms used in crimes. Due to limited numbers and access of these types of firearms, it is assumed passage of this proposal would not encompass a significant number, if any, future perpetrators. DOC assumes no fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** assume the proposal would have no measurable fiscal impact the Office of Prosecution Services or county prosecutors.
