#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Department of Economic Development** and the **Department of Agriculture** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Missouri Department of Transportation** received a letter from the U.S. Department of Transportation that states this proposal will violate the Highway Beautification Act and the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control which are both federal laws. The violation would result in a ten percent annual loss of federal funds, which is \$80,000,000.

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

## FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill allows any agri-tourism business to place advertising signage along the roads and highways of the state on private property, with the permission of the property owner, or within the right-of-way of a road or highway, with the consent of the Department of Transportation.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
