ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture, Office of State Courts Administrator, City of Kansas City** assume there will be no fiscal impact to their city.

Officials from the **City of Centralia** assume this is already required by the city ordinances and therefore will have no fiscal impact on their city.

Officials from **Cass County** assume there would be no direct impact on general revenue with regards to this proposal. Cass County assumes that the sheriff or local law enforcement would enforce this proposal and that it is up to the owner to have records and show evidence of vaccinations. Cass County assumes that the county will not have to keep or maintain records on animals and thus would have no fiscal impact on local county funds.

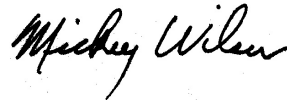
