

HB 35 -- Income Tax Deduction for Alternative Energy Sources

Beginning January 1, 2010, this bill authorizes an income tax deduction for any taxpayer who purchases certain qualified fuel cell property that is installed for a dwelling located in the United States and used as the principal residence by the taxpayer. The deduction will be 50% of the purchase price or \$1,000, whichever is less.

The bill also authorizes an income tax deduction for any taxpayer who purchases solar energy property to generate electricity for a dwelling in this state and used as a residence by the taxpayer. The deduction will be 50% of the purchase price or \$4,000, whichever is less.

The provisions of the bill will expire December 31 six years from the effective date.
