HB 1125 -- Orders of Protection

Sponsor: Kander

This bill changes the laws regarding the enforcement of orders of protection by establishing the same remedies for violations of exparte and full orders of protection.

The bill also specifies that any person who has previously pled guilty to or has been found guilty of violating an ex parte order of protection or a full order of protection within five years of any subsequent violation will be guilty of a class D felony.
