1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1787, Section 571.107, Page 16, Lines
2 35 to 41 by removing all of said Lines from the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 “(5) Any meeting of the governing body of a unit of local government; or any meeting of
5 the general assembly or a committee of the general assembly, except that nothing in this
6 subdivision shall preclude a member of the body holding a valid concealed carry endorsement
7 from carrying a concealed firearm at a meeting of the body which he or she is a member. Nothing
8 in this subdivision shall preclude a member of the general assembly, a full time employee of the
9 general assembly employed pursuant to section 17, article III, Constitution of Missouri, or
10 legislative employees of the general assembly as determined under section 21.155, holding a
11 valid concealed carry endorsement, from carrying a concealed firearm in the state capitol building
12 or at a meeting, whether of the full body of a house of the general assembly or a committee
13 thereof, that is held in the state capitol building. Possession of a firearm in a vehicle on the
14 premises shall not be a criminal offense so long as the firearm is not removed from the vehicle or
15 brandished while the vehicle is on the premises;

16 (6) Except as provided in subdivision (5) of subsection 1 of this section the general
17 assembly, supreme court, county or municipality may by rule,”; and
